NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, Thatwe , the said Lamar Kennedy and William D. Yarborough

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Southern Bank and Trust Company, its successors and assigns forever:

All that lot of land situate on the northeast side of United States Highway No. 276 (also known as the Greenville-Laurens Road), near the town of Mauldin, in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as all of Lot 22, a portion of Lots 21 and 23, a strip 40 feet in width lying northeast of and adjacent to the rear of Lot 22, and a strip 40 feet in width lying southeast of and adjacent to Lots 22 and 23 on plat of property of Thomas B. Cooper, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, April, 1948, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "T", at Pages 299 and 300, and having according to a survey made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, February 2, 1957, the following metes and bounds:
