All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of **Greenville**, on the **Eastern side of Pennwood Lane, near Paris Mountain, being shown and designated as Lot No. 45 on plat of Imperial Hills, made by C.C. Jones, Civil Engineer, dated August, 1964 and recorded in the R.M.C.
