MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, R. F. Hughes and Marguerite G. Hughes of Greenville County

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Three Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100-----(\$ 3,500.00). Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as Loa No. 51 as shown on a plat of the subdivision of Colonial Hills, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book FFF at Page 102 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of East Lee Road at the joint front corner of lots 50 and 51 and running thence with the southern side of East Lee Road, N. 80-21 E. 105.1 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Brushy Creek Road; thence with the western side of Brushy Creek Road, S. 33-55 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 65-05 W. 55.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-00 W. 115 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots 50 and 51, thence with the joint line of said lots N. 9-00 E. 150 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Collins and Williams, Inc. be deed dated September 27, 1967 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
