SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Cecil W. McClimon

in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, am well

and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of

Four Thousand and no/100 - - - - (\$ 4,000.00) Dollars,

with interest from the date hereof at the rate of eight per cent (8 %) per annum, unpaid interest to

bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

Fifty and no/100 - - - - (\$ 50.00) Dollars

due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any, incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I the said Cecil W. McClimon

in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the said mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church and southeast therefrom, about two miles South from the City of Greer, known and designated as Lots Nos. 31 and 32 on a plat of property made for the W. A. Mullinax Estate by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated October 31, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book T, page 477.

BEGINNING at a point off western edge of State Highway No. 14 on southern edge of unnamed Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 30 and 31 and runs thence with southern edge of said Street N. 57-00 E. 150 feet to a stake at intersection of the above unnamed Street with another unnamed Street; thence with eastern edge of second unnamed Street S. 30-00 E. 170 feet to a point, joint corner of Lots Nos. 32 and 24; thence as dividing line between Lots Nos. 24, 32 and 31, S. 57-00 W. 150 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 30 and 31; thence with dividing line of lots Nos. 30 and 31, N. 29-50 W. 170 feet to a point of beginning.
