paid 8cmi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will nore fully appear.

, in hand and truly paid by the said Piedmont Construction Company

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Piedmont Construction Company, its heirs and assigns; FOREVER:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot Number 19 of Block "Y" as shown on a plat of Riverside, recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 323 and "K" at page 283, and being more particularly described according to a more recent survey by J. C. Hill, March 12, 1955, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the northern side of Highlawn Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 18 & 19, Block "Y", which pin is 350 feet east of intersection of Highlawn Avenue and Finley Street (formerly Green Street) and running thence with Highlawn Avenue, S 79-45 E 50 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 20; thence with the line of said lot N 10-15 E 125 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of a 15 foot alley; thence with said alley N 79-45 W 50 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 18; thence with line of said lot S 10-15 W 125 feet to the point of beginning.
