To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, T. H. Jenkins and Betty B. Jenkins, of Greenville County,

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Sixteen Thousand, Eight Hundred and No/100-----(3, 16, 800, 00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

therein specified in installments of One Hundred Twenty-Nine and 68/100----(\$ 120.68) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been poid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid pripicipal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable. 20 _-years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any ply-Laws or the Charter of the Mortage, or any stipulations set out in this mortage, the whole anount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collateral given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgager may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgager for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgager's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any turner sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (33.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and turly paid by the Mortgage and hefore the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 23 on plat of Rolling Acres, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book UUU , at Page 89 , and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Robertson Street, corner of Lot No. 24, and running thence along said street, S. 5-33 W. 105 feet; thence along the curve of the intersection of Dablgreen Lane, the chord of which is S. 39-04 W. 42.2 feet; thence along said lane, S. 71-26 W. 100 feet; thence along the line of Lot 22, N. 13-02 W. 191.9 feet; thence S. 84-27 E. 175.5 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Clyde A. Robertson, et al. by deed dated April 10, 1969 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 865, at Page 553.

The mortgagors' promissory note referred to above, contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
