Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditanents, and appurtenances to the same be longing or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise be had thereform, and including all heating, pluming, and lighting fatures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully setzed of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrance. Whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever detend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomseever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows

- That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said
 note, at the times and in the manner therein provided. Failure to pay promptly shall, at the option of
 the holder, permit a late charge to be charged.
- 2. That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxe, insurance premiums public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee; and that all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the blottgage drit and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter arcted on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgages regained loss by fire and other bazards, in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgages, as faced as a receptable to it, and that he does hereby assign to the Mortgages all such policies, and that of such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgages and have attached thereto loss payable coases in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgages. Failure to provide insurance shall, at the option of the holder, permit the holder acquire such insurance as it deems necessary for the holder's protection, exclusive of the mortgagor's protection and to charge the cost of same to the mortgage debt.
- 4. That he will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may require the maker, co-maker or endotser of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgagor to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgagee shall become a part of mortgage debt.
- 6. That, at the option of the holder, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgage, on the first day of each month, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the annual taxes, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the fallure of the Mortgagor to pay all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments. Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said times and charge all advances therefor to the mortgage debt. Any deficiency in the amount of such aggregate monthly payment, shall, unless made good by the Mortgagee mortgage. The Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" into the except is the Gold per dollar of any installment which is not paid within ten (10) days from the due date thereof to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments. If, however, such monthly payments shall not be sufficient to pay such items when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency. Such payment will be made within fifteen (15) days after written notice from the Mortgagee stating the amount of the deficiency, which notice may be given by mail.

That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. A default in this mortgage and the note which it secures shall likewise constitute a default as to any other note and mortgage, held by the holder, executed or assumed by the mortgagor(s).
- 9. That, at the option of the Mortgager, this mortgage shall become due and payable forthwith if the Mortgagor shall convey away said mortgaged premises, or if the tiffe shall become vested in any other person in any manner whatsoever other than by death of the Mortgagor. The Mortgagor shall not place a subsequent or junior mortgage upon the above described premises without the written permission of the Mortgagee.
