NOW KNOW ALL MEN That the Mortgagors, in order better to accure the payment of the Note above mentioned in accordance with its terms, and all other sums mentioned therein or herein, to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS to the Mortgagers in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the seating of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real property:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a part of the lands of Riverside Land Company, known as Edverside and being known and designated on a plat of said land made by Carter & Pringle, Surveyors (which plat is of record in the 1400 Office for Greenville County) and is known and designated as LOT No. 13 of Block V and has a frontage thereon of 50 on Colonial Avenue and a depth of 125 feet to an Alley.

This being the same property conveyed to R. C. and Irene Shelton by deed of Mary M. League dated June 22, 1946 and recorded in the EMC Office for Granwille County in Deed Book 294, at page 149.

The said 3.C. Shelton died testate in Greenville County in April 1951, leaving the above described property to the Grantor herein.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise inclient or appertuining,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever,

And the Mertgagors do hereby bind themselves to WARRANT AND FOREVER DEFEND all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee from and against themselves and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, that if the Mortgagors shall well and truly pay with the Mortgagor all sums of money evidenced by the Note herein mentioned, or any subsequent Note as herein provided, and shall pay the taxes, insurance premiums and other amounts herein mentioned at the time and in the manner specified in said Note and herein, then these presents and the estate hereby granted shall cease, determine and he vold, and thereupon the satisfaction and discharge of this instrument may be completed and executed by the duly appointed and acting manager of the Mortgagor.

And the Mortgagors, for themselves and for their heirs and assigns, hereby covenant with the Mortgagee as follows:

- 1. That the Mortgagors shall insure the mortgaged buildings against such hazards, in such amounts and with such carriers as may be approved by the Mortgagee, and shall assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgage, and in case they shall at any time fail or neglect so to do, then the Mortgage may cause the same to be insured in its name, or as interests may appear, and reimburse itself for the premiums and expenses of such insurance, with interest thereon at the maximum legal rate payable on the next succeeding instalment date fixed in said Note, and the same shall stand secured by this mortgage.
- 2. That the Mortgagors shall pay, as the same may become due, all taxes by whatsoever authority legally imposed on the property hereby mortgaged, and in case they shall at any time neglect or fail so to do, then the Mortgagee may pay such taxes, and reinburse itself for the same with interest thereon at the maximum legal rate, payable on the next succeeding instalment date fixed in said Mote, and that the same shall stand secured by this mortgage.
- 3. That upon default in the payment of any instalment of said Note, or of any insurance premium, taxes or assessments or in the performance of any of the requirements contained in said Note, or of any of the conditions of this mortgage, then the Mortgages shall have the right to declare the entire amount of the debt secured hereby to be immediately due and payable, and to proceed without notice to enforce the collection of the same, together with interest, attorney's fees and all other amounts secured hereby or permitted by law.
- 4. The holder of this mortgage, in any action to foreclose the same, shall be entitled, without regard to the value of the mortgaged premises, or the adequacy of any security for the mortgage debt, to the appointment of a receiver of the rents and profits of the mortgaged premises, and such rents and profits ore bereby, in the event of any default in the payment of said Note according to its terms, assigned to the holder of this mortgage.
- The covenants herein contained shall bind and the benefits shall inure to the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
