WHEREAS, We, B. J. GUSTIN and DOROTHY D. GUSTIN

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) is well and truly indebted unto JULIAN A. GAULT and HELEN B. GAULT

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagee's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of NINETEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100ths-----

Dollars (\$19,000.00) due and payable

in equal monthly installments upon the 23rd day of each and every calendar month hereafter, with the final payment due and owing August 23, 1994, said payments being in the sum of \$134.29.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7% per centum per annum, to be paid monthly

WHEREAS, the Mortgagee may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagee's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagee, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagee may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagee in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Conway Drive, being shown as Lot No. 3 on plat of Pleasantburg Forest made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, August, 1956, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG at page 163, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Conway Drive at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 2, N. 20-31 W. 198.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 64-57 E. 102.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 4, S. 14-49 E. 212.4 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Conway Drive; thence with the north side of Conway Drive, S. 72-51 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagees herein by deed of the mortgagees of even date to be recorded herewith in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagee covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagee further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagee and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
