Landrum , South Carolina 29365. , berein called "Borrower." are (la) justly indebted to the United States of America, ecting through the Parmera Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, herein called the "Government," as syldenced by a certain promissory note, herein called "the note," dated

October 7 10 69 for the brincipal sum of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$ 13.500.00, with interest at the rate of Six and 1/4--- percent (.62. %) per annum, executed by Borrower and payable to the order of the Government in installments as specified therein, the final installment being due on .. Dotober 74. 2002. which note authorizes acceleration of the entire indebtedness at the option of the Government upon any default by Borrower; and

WHEREAS, the note evidences a loan to Borrower in the principal amount specified therein, made with the purpose and intention that the Government, at any time, may assign the note and insure the payment thereof pursuant to the Consolidated Parmers Home Administration Act of 1961, or Title V of the Housing Act of 1949; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, it may be assigned from time to time and each holder of the insured note, in turn, will be the insured lender; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured lender in connection with the loan; and WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insured lender set forth in the insurance endorsement may be callified to a specified portion of the payments on the note, to be designated the "sanual charge"; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the insurance of payment of the note will be that the holder will forego his rights and remedies against Borrower and any others in connection with said loan, as well as any benefit of this instrument, and will accept the benefits of such insurance in lieu thereof, and upon the Government's request will assign the note to the Government; and

WHEREAS, It is the purpose and intent of this instrument that, among other things, at all times when the note is held by the Government, in the event the Government should assign the instrument without insurance of the note, this instrument shall secure payment of the note; or in the overall the control and the second second the control and the contro ment by reason of any default by Borrower:
