11. That in the event this mortgage should be foreclosed, the Mortgagor expressly waives the benefits of Sections 45-88 through 45-90.1 of the 1902 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, or any other appraisement laws.

The Mortgagee covenants and agrees as follows:

- That should the Mortgagor prepay a portion of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage and subsequently fall
 to make a payment or payments as required by the aforesaid promissory note, any such prepayment may be applied toward
 the missed payment or payments, insolar as possible, in order that the principal debt will not be held contractually delinquent.
- 2. That the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the above described premises until there is a default under this mortgage or the note secured hereby, and it is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

It is mutually agreed that if there is a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgage, all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgage shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed.
