Abney Mills, Federal Credit Union, a corporation,

"ALL that certain piece, percel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereefter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being into State of South Corollan, County of Greenville, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 155, Section 1, as shown on plat entitled "Subdivision for Abney Mills, Brandon Plant, Greenville, South Carolina", made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, Greenville, S.C., February, 1959, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at page(s) 56 to 59. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 22 Bryant Street and fronts thereon 61 feet.

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed from Abney Mills, a South Carolina corporation, dated May 12th, 1959, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 624, at page 385.
