Together with all and singular rights, mambers, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appartaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting is fixtures now or hereafter allached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
