MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, J. Odell Shaver, of Greenville County

......(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST-FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Fifteen Thousand, Four Hundred and No/100----(\$ 15, 400, 00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the options of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgage to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dallars (33.90) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the seating of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by the presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described-real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township, within the corporate limits of the Town of Mauldin, and being known and designated as Lot Number 29 of a subdivision known as Glendale II, a plat of which is of record in the R, M, C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book OOO at Page 55, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southeastern side of Verdin Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29 and running thence with the Southeastern side of Verdin Drive, N. 19-05 E, 67.5 feet to a point; thence continuing with the Southeastern side of Verdin Drive, N. 32-45 E, 67.5 feet to a point at the joint corner of Lots 29 and 30; thence S. 47-49 E. 149.7 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 20 and 30; thence S. 28-24 W. 60 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 28 and 29; thence N. 76-55 W. 144.6 feet to a point on the Southeastern side of Verdin Drive at the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Central Realty Corporation by its deed dated February 24, 1970, to be recorded herewith.

The mortgagor's promissory note referred to above contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
