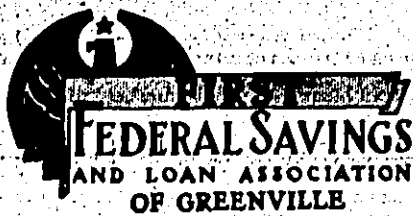

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Florine A. Hardaway, of Greenville County,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Five Thousand and No/100----- (\$ 5,000.00)

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note contains

a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of

Seventy and 69/100----- (\$ 70.69) Dollars each on the first day of each

month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment

of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner

paid, to be due and payable 8 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township, near the Town of Simpsonville, as shown on a plat of the Property of Florine Hardaway by Carolina Engineering and Surveying Co., dated November 14, 1963, recorded in Plat Book EEE, page 139 in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, containing 10.1 acres, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint corner with the Dunk Milam and Pollard property as shown on the plat and running thence S. 63-57 E. 370.0 feet to a stone; thence S. 27-30 W. 1,194.8 feet along the line of the C. M. Todd property to a concrete marker; thence N. 63-20 W. 370.0 feet along the line of the L. Blakely property to an iron pin; thence N. 27-30 E. 1,190.8 feet along the line of the Dunk Milam property to an iron pin, the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Dunk Milam by deed dated November 15, 1963 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 739, at Page 527.

TOGETHER WITH an easement for ingress and egress from said property through the property of Dunk Milam to a public road. The description of said easement is found in instrument dated December 11, 1970 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 904, at Page 323, reference to which is hereby craved.
