Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage, or the title to the premises described herein, or should the expenses incurred hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
