PROPERTY NO. 5.

Premises: Steubenville, Ohio

ALL that certain tract of land with the improvements thereon erected situate in the Village of Winterville, Jefferson County, Ohio described as follows:

Parcel No. 1.

Situate in Sec. 19, T. 7, Island Creek Twp., Rg. 2, Village of Winterville, Jefferson County, Ohio, and being part of Luray Industries, Incorporated Land described in Deed Book 431, Page 235 on Record in the Jefferson County Deeds Records Office: described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Luray Industries lands; thence North 58° 12' West along a Northeasterly line thereof, 63.28 feet; thence North 18° 59' East along a Southeasterly line thereof, 33.06 feet to the North Right of Way line State Route 49; thence with said line, North 76° 34' West 60.0 feet to a Railroad Spike; thence North 16° 51' East 50.09 feet to an Iron Pin, being The Place of True Beginning; thence from said true beginning North 76° 34' West, 180.03 feet to an iron pin; thence North 16° 32' East 221.80 feet to an Iron Pin; thence South 71° 51' East, 179.85 feet to an Iron Pin; thence an arc distance 66.76 feet to a concrete monument, said arc having a radius of 450 feet, a central angle of 8° 30', a chord length of 66.70 feet and a chord bearing of South 18° 23' West; thence South 14° 03' West 64.0 feet to an iron pin; thence South 16° 51' West, 76.38 feet to the iron pin at the Place of true beginning, containing 0.873 Acres, according to a survey dated September 11, 1969 and revised November 6, 1969 by John S. Lawrence, Ohio Registered Surveyor No. 4653, be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highways.

Parcel No. 2.

A non-exclusive easement for ingress to and egress from Parcel No. 1 above described and State Route #43 as created in a document entitled "Instrument of Easements and Restrictive Covenants" by and between Luray Industries Incorporated and Robert Hall Clothes Steubenville Corp. dated December 20, 1969 and recorded in Volume 485, Page 237 of Jefferson County Records.
