WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Alice Street (formerly known as Gillespie Street), near Brandon Mills, in a section known as "Free Town", near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 15, as shown on a plat of property of Ida J. Seyle, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat A at page 433, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Alice Street (formerly known as Gillespie Street) at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 14 in an Easterly direction 130 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 9; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 9 and 8 N. 15½ W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Westerly direction 130 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Alice Street; thence with the Eastern side of Alice Street S. 15½ E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to Robert Smith by deed of T. J. Seyle, dated January 12, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 38 at page 517. Robert G. Smith died testate and devised the premises hereinabove described to the mortgagor herein.
