with interest thereon from date at the rate of Eight (8%)per centum per annum, to be paid: quarterly.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assions:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northeastern side of White Horse Road and being known and designated as Lot Nos. 20 and 21 on plat of Green Pastures Subdivision, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book III at Page 133 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of White Horse Road, joint front corner of Lot No. 20 and property of Morris Green and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 63-04 E. 148.2 feet; thence with the rear line of Lot Nos. 20 and 21, S. 64-10 E. 244.8 feet to an iron pin, the common corner of Lot Nos. 5, 21 and 22; thence with the common line of Lot Nos. 21 and 22, S. 62-09 W. 293.4 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of White Horse Road; thence with the northeastern side of said road, N. 27-47 W. 301.2 feet to an iron pin, the point of Beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
