WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for texes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure, the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and lying on the southern side of Garrison Road and containing two acres and being shown on a plat entitled "Property of William R. Godfrey" having been made by Webb Surveying and Mapping Company dated May 1972, with said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4-Q at Page 123 and haveing according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Garrison Road at a point 600 feet west of the intersection of the said Garrison Road and Snow Road, thence running with the said Garrison Road S50-58W 290 feet to a point in the center of said Garrison Road; thence running 8 39-02E 300 feet to an iron pin; thence running N 50-58E 290 feet to an iron pin; thence running N 39-02W 300 feet to a point in the center of said Garrison Road, the place and point of Englinning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever,

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrance except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same of any part thereof.
