WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeast side of Henderson Road, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 20 on plat of Section E-1 of Gower Estates as shown on plat prepared by Campbell & Clarkson, Surveyors, December 1964, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book BBB, at Page 70, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Henderson Road at the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 20, and runs thence with the line of Lot 19, S. 33-17 E. 299.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-34 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 21, N. 28-18 W. 292.7 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Henderson Road; thence with the southeast side of Henderson Road, S. 55-45 E. 175 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Conyers & Gower, Inc. by deed dated February 5, 1969 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 864, at Page 65.
