"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, designated as Lot No. 40 on a plat of Edgar C. Waldrop Property, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book B at Page 171, and having the courses and distances shown on said plat, fronting 50 feet on the West side of Selma Street with a depth of 150 feet.
