BEGINNING at an iron pin on line of lands now or formerly of Mrs. Sallie E. Sims, joint corner with lands now or formerly of J. R. Sims, running thence with joint line of lands of the said Sallie E. Sims, S. 35-1/2 E., 150 feet to an iron pin, joint corner with lands now or formerly of J. R. Sims and corner of a 25 foot right-of-way or road which leads from the Dunklin Bridge Road northeasterly, separating the lands of J. R. Sims and lands of R. L. Sims, and which affords a way of ingress and egress to the property of C. E.
