

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Dunean Mills Village, and being more particularly described as LOT NO. 94, Section 4 as shown on plat entitled "Subdivision for Dunean Mills, Greenville, S.C." made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S.C. on June 7, 1948, revised June 15, 1948 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at pages 173-177, inclusive.
