(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:
WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto UNITED FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Fountain Inn, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100

DOLLARS (\$ 25,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of NINE per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

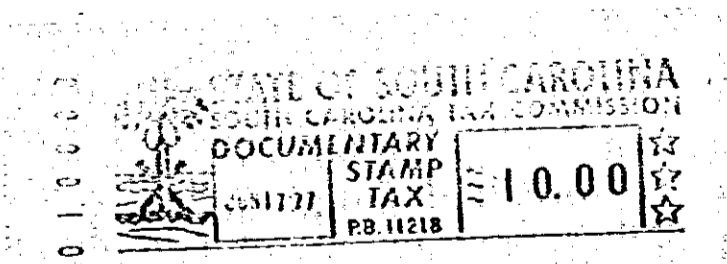
All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 4 and 5 on a plat of property of Mrs. George Baker and Mrs. Lee McDonald, prepared by Albert M. Sanders, Engineer, March 20, 1971 and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western edge of South Carolina Highway No. 20 at the joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4 (said point being 37.5 feet from the center line of S.C. Highway 20) and running thence along S.C. Highway 20, S. 27-38 W., 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5 thence continuing with S.C. Highway 20, S. 27-38 W., 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 5 and 6; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 62-22 W., 124.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 5 and 6; thence N. 25-21 E., 100.05 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence N. 27-14 E., 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 3 and 4; thence with the joint line of Lots 3 and 4, S. 62-22 E., 129.3 feet to an iron pin being the point of beginning.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to the mortgagor by Deed of Joseph Carlton Bates, III recorded February 14, 1974 in Deed Book 993 at page 767 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County.

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
