

Rider to mortgage of South Carolina District of The Wesleyan Church (formerly known as South Carolina Conference of The Wesleyan Methodist Church of America) to Home Savings and Loan Association in the original amount of \$4,200.00

"ALL those other lots of land adjoining the lot above described and being known and identified as Lots Nos. 11 and 12 on plat of Monaghan Annex, recorded in Plat Book C at page 63, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Smythe Street (now Woodside Avenue) and running thence South 6 1/4 West 54.4 feet to an iron pin; thence North 83 1/4 West 103 feet to corner of Lot No. 13; thence with line of said lot South 8 1/4 West 54.4 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 10; thence with said lot South 83 1/4 East 102 feet to Smythe Street and the point of BEGINNING."

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of M. L. Crain by deed dated July 26, 1944, recorded July 27, 1944, in Deed Book 265 at page 421 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

The above description was taken from the original plat but is subject to a strip of land taken from the front of said lot for the purpose of widening Woodside Avenue.

ALSO:

"ALL those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate on the southern side of Parker Road near Monaghan Mill, being shown and designated as Lots 16 and 17 on a plat of Monaghan Annex, recorded in Plat Book C at page 63 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Southern side of West Parker Road at corner of Lot 15 which pin is 250 feet from Smythe Street and running thence with the line of Lot 15 South 7-27 West 165 feet to an iron pin; thence North 83-19 West 100 feet to pin at rear corner of Lot 18; thence with the line of Lot 18 North 7-27 East 166.2 feet to pin on Southern side of West Parker Road; thence with the Southern side of West Parker Road South 82-33 East 100 feet to the point of BEGINNING."

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of J. P. Stevens Co., Inc., dated September 19, 1955, recorded January 23, 1957, in Deed Book 569 at page 405 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
