That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bring and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the East side of Craigwood Road, being shown as all of Lot No. 30 on plat entitled "Section Two, Property of Elizabeth L. Marchant," prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in July 1963, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office, Greenville County, S.C., and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
