"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Pennwood Lane and Tamarack Trail, and known and designated as Lot No. 22 of a subdivision known as Fontana Forest, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book YY at Page 171, and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Pennwood Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23 running thence with the joint line of said lots \$.42-30 W., 150 feet to an iron pin; running thence with the rear line of Lots 35 and 36 N. 31-22 W., 148.4 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Tamarack Trail; running thence with said trail N. 72-23 E., 110 feet to the intersection of said trail with Pennwood Lane, which intersection is curved, the chord of which is \$.74-24 E., 41.8 feet; running thence with Pennwood Lane \$.41-11 E., 51.2 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
