in Florence, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may
designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Two hundred sixty
and 31/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 260.31), commencing on the first day of
February, 1978, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and
interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and
payable on the first day of January, 2008

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the
payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor
in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does
grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described
property situated in the county of Greenville
State of South Carolina; being shown and designated as Lot 223 on a Plat of
BELLE MEADE, Section III, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book GG, at Page 187. Said Lot fronts 80.0 feet on
Pine Creek Drive; runs back a uniform depth of 150.0 feet, and is
80.0 feet across the rear.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by deed of
