All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the southeastern corner of the intersection of White Horse Road and Gordon Avenue, being shown and designated as Lots No. 5 and 6 on Plat of "Property of W. D. Workman" prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, recorded in Plat Book F at page 288 and being described, according to said plat, more particularly, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of White Horse Road at the ojoint front corner of Lots No. 4 and 5 and running thence along the eastern side of said Road, N. 10-49 E., 107.5 feet to a point at the intersection of White Horse Road and Gordon Avenue; thence along the southern side of Gordon Avenue, N. 80-08 E., 159 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots No. 6 and 7; thence S, 10-49 W., 145 feet to an iron pin at the Joint rear corner of Lots No. 4 and 5; thence along the common line of gaid lots, N. 86-30 W., 150 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of White Horse Road, the point of beginning.
