State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying, situate, and being in Butler Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 101, as shown on Plat entitled "Subdivision for W. C. Stewart", prepared by Woodward Engineering Co., dated March, 1946, and recorded in the RNC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book NN at Page 200, and being the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and in the manner therein provided.
