Seventy-five and 40/100ths -----(§ 175.40) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal biliness, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable

WHEREAS, said rate further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any fulure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payallle, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEBEAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes insurance premiums repairs, or for any other purpose,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern corner of the intersection of Fairfield Road, with Englewood Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 as shown on a plat entitled ENGLEWOOD ESTATES, SECTION B, made by J. Mac Richardson, R.L.S., dated November, 1951, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book BB at page 11, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Fairfield Road at the Ojoint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 and running thence along the Castern side of Fairfield Road, N. 11-10 E., 57.0 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Fairfield Road and Englewood Drive, a distance of 30 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Englewood Drive; thence along the southern side of Englewood Drive, S. 87-30 E., 148.3 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 14; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 2-55 E., 75.4 Pfeet to an iron pin; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, N. 87-42 W., 191.6 feet to an iron pin, on the eastern side of Fairfield Road, the point of beginning.
