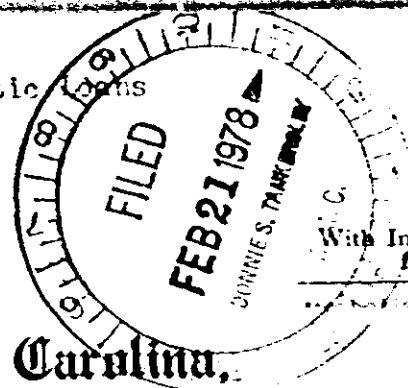

WHEREAS We the said Edward E. Stroud and Lois Stroud

(Hereinafter also styled the

mortgagor) in and by their certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand firmly held and bound unto

(hereinafter also styled the mortgagee) in the penal sum of

conditioned for the payment in lawful money of the United States of America of the full and just sum of

Eight thousand Two hundred Eighty and 00/100 (\$8,280.00)

as in and by the said Note and conditions thereof, reference thereto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that We the said Edward E. Stroud and Lois Stroud in consideration of the said debt, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the conditions of the said Note; which with all its provisions is hereby made a part hereof; and also in consideration of Three Dollars to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid, by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Liberty Loans Corp. d/b/a Domestic Loans.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot in Greenville County, State of South Carolina near the City of Greenville, being situate on the northern corner of the intersection of Penarth Street (Formerly Noble Street) and Lilac Street and being known and designated as lot eighteen (18) of the property of William F. Timmons, Jr. as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book "XX" Page 2, Greenville County P.M.C. Office and also shown on plat and survey of C.C. Jones, dated June 12, 1962, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron at the Northeast side of Penarth Street, front corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence with the side line of said Lots, N. 58-53 E., 140 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 17; thence with the line of lot 17, S. 31-07 E., 150 feet to an iron pin on Lilac Street; thence with said street, S. 58-53 W., 120 feet to a stake; thence around a curve to the right, 130 feet to the beginning corner.
