

SCHEDULE A

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the east side of Greer-Gowansville Road in the Counties of Greenville and Spartanburg, State of South Carolina, containing 62.10 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of J. BEGINNING at a point on the east side of Greer-Gowansville Road and property now or formerly of C. P. Williams and running thence with the line of property of C. P. Williams N. 82-19 E. 836 feet to an old stone on the county line of Greenville and Spartanburg; thence continuing with the property of C. P. Williams S. 88-34 E. 1,266 feet to a point on the bank of Middle Tyger River; thence with Middle Tyger River as the line, the following courses and distances: S. 27 E. 153 feet, S. 18-39 E. 900 feet, S. 16-15 E. 100 feet, S. 2-14 W. 287 feet to a point on the bank of Middle Tyger River and property now or formerly of Briggs; thence with the line of property of Briggs N. 88-15 W. 1,575 feet to an old iron pin; thence N. 86-15 W. 211 feet to a point on the east side of Greer-Gowansville Road; thence with the Greer-Gowansville Road, the following traverse courses and distances: N. 31 W. 680.5 feet, N. 25-15 W. 418 feet, N. 32-45 W. 329 feet to the point of beginning.
