MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS. We, James M. and Odessa S. Thompson

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto **Termpian Inc., Of Greenville,
107 E. North Street, Greenville, SC**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

Three Thousand Three hundred Twelve and no/100-----Dollars (\$3312.00) due and payable in thirty six (36) monthly installments of Ninety Two (\$92.00) dollars each, commencing on the 1st day of May, 1979 due and payable on the 1st day of each month thereafter until paid in full.

with interest thereon from **March 23, 1979** at the rate of **12.45** per centum per annum, to be paid: **annually**

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of **Greenville**, **All that piece, parcel of lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being know and designated as Lot No. 2 on the Southern side of Morton Road as shown on a plat entitled "Azalee Thompson Estate" prepared by C. O. Riddle, dated August 28, 1970 and having , according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:**

Begining at an iron pin in the center of Morton Road, at the joint front corners of Lots 1 and 2, running thence down the joint line of said lots, S. 23-47E 531.7 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 83-40 W. 171.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner Lots 2 and 4; running thence N. 23-47 W. 226.5 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot 3; running thence N. 66-13 E. 68.3 feet to an iron pin; running thence down the joint line of Lots 2 and 3 N. 23-47 W. 253.8 feet to an iron pine to the center line of Morton Road; running thence down the center line of Morton road N. 66-13 E. 95 feet to the point of beginning.

The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

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
