NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the western side of Cavendish Close, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and known and designated as Lot No. 18 of a subdivision known as Gray Fox Run, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5-P at Page 9 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Cavendish Close at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19 and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 87-24 W., 140 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-36 E., 95 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 17 and 18; running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 87-24 E., 140 feet to an iron pin on the horthwestern side of Cavendish Close; running thence S. 2-36 W., 95 feet to the point of beginning.

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced bereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums 50 advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
