(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND AND NO/100-----Dollars (\$ 23,000.00) due and payable

according to the terms of the promissory note,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eleven(11%)per centum per annum, to be paid: monthly.

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 17 of a subdivision known as Essex Court, a plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W at page 31, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the western side of Essex Court at the joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17 and running thence with the western side of Essex Court following the curvature of the turnaround approximately N. 24-22 W. 85 feet to a point at the joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18 (now Lot 39); thence N. 67-46 W. 69 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 17 and 18 (now Lot 39); thence S. 01-50 E. 100 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 16 and 17; thence N. 86-15 E. 95.8 feet to a point on the western side of Essex Court, the point of beginning.
