To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Rosamond Enterprises, Inc.

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) in the full and just sum of

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;


NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, burgained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, burgain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 19 as shown on a plat of Holly Tree Plantation, Phase II, Section II, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects dated January 10, 1974, which plat is of record in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5-D at Page 47 and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the cul de sac of Pecan Hill Drive at the joint front corners of Lots No. 19 and 20, and running thence up the joint line of Lots No. 19 and 20, N. 229 W. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 39-02 E. 119.37 feet to the joint rear corners of Lots No. 18 and 19; thence S. 71-55 E. 135 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots No. 19 and 14; running thence down the joint line of Lots No. 19 and 14, S. 24 W. 170 feet to a point on the cul de sac of Pecan Hill Drive; thence around the cul de sac of Pecan Hill Drive, the chord of which is N. 76-26 W. 25 feet to a point; thence S. 74-45 W. 25 feet; thence S. 45-56 W. 25 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor by deed of Ruby M. Rosamond dated February 15, 1980, recorded February 18, 1980, in Deed Book //20 at Page 682.

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
