"All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being the major portion of Lot No. 9 on plat of Dogwood Terrace Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book UU at page 5 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina and having, according to plat made by C. C. Jones, January 1964, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
