"ALL that certain piece, purcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Crestone Street (formerly King Street) near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 35 as shown on plat of property of B. F. Martin, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book F at Page 140 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an rion pin on the Western side of Crestone Street (formerly King Street) at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 34 and 35 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 34 in a westerly direction 146.4 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 39; thence with the line of Lot No. 39 in a northerly direction 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 35 and 36; thence with the line of Lot No. 36 in an easterly direction 147.7 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Crestone Street (formerly King Street); thence with the western side of Crestone Street (formerly King Street) in a southerly direction to the point of beginning.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is Mfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all hers and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced bereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing
- (2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such a mounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay held by the Mortgagee, and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does alk premising the mortgage of the halance owing on being authorize each intricence company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee. hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.

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
