ALL that certain lot of land with all buildings and improvements thereon situate on the Southeast side of Pimlico Road in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being shown as Lot No. 485 on plat of Section D, Gower Estates, made by N. C. Clarkson and R. K. Campbell, May 1964, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book RR, at Pages 192 and 193, reference to said plat being made for a more particular description of said property.
