2. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment, shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgagee may collect a "flate charge" not to exceed four cents (\$2) for each dollar (\$1) of each payment more than fifteen (15) days in arrears to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinouent payments.

3. If the total of payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceeding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor.
