

Rider to Mortgage of James Ralph Rochester and Melba Hughey Rochester and Holiday Enterprises, Inc. to Home Savings and Loan Association of the Piedmont, Easley, South Carolina

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Riverview Drive at the joint corner of the within described lot and a 36 foot wide alley and running thence along the Northern side of the alley N 82-07 E 102.8 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 47; thence along the line of Lot 47 N 1-57 W 266.6 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of South Valley Lane; thence along South Valley Lane, N 66-40 W 59.7 feet to an iron pin; thence along the curve of the intersection of South Valley Lane and Riverview Drive S 55-13 W 63.3 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Riverview Drive; thence along Riverview Drive S 3-11 E 268.5 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
