with interest thereon from date at the rate of 15 per centum per annum, to be paid: at maturity.

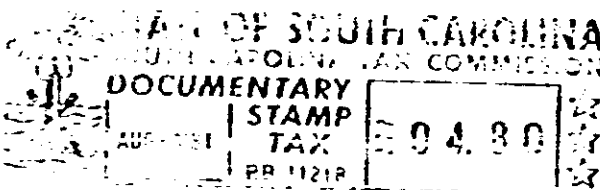

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, the Mortgagee's heirs, successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Shelton Road and being shown as 2.98 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of Property of Col. Frank J. MacNeese made by Terry T. Dill dated April 18, 1967, reference being craved to said plat for a more particular metes and bounds description.

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Malvin W.
