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MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE
TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being at Taylors, and being more particularly described as Lot 74, as shown on a plat entitled "Section Two, Subdivision for Burlington Industries, Inc., Taylors, South Carolina", made by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, July 8, 1965, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book JJJ, at page 49.
