

AND the mortgagor does hereby bind himself and his heirs and successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs and assigns, from and against himself and his heirs and successors, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties that the mortgagor, his heirs and successors and assigns, shall keep any building erected on the premises insured against loss and damage by fire for the benefit of the mortgagee, for an amount not less than the sum shown above, with such company as shall be approved by the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs and assigns, and shall deliver the policy to the mortgagee; and in default thereof, the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs or assigns may effect such insurance and reimburse themselves under this mortgage for the expense thereof, together with interest thereon at the rate provided in the note from the date of its payment. ANDITIS AGREED, by and between the parties, that if the mortgagor, his heirs and successors or assigns, shall fail to be all taxes and assessments upon the premise when they shall first become payable, then the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs or assigns, may cause the same to be paid, together with all penalties and costs incurred thereon, and reimburse themselves under this mortgage for the sum so paid, with interest thereon at the rate provided in the note from the date of such payment.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties that upon any default for a period of more than tendays being made in the payment of the note or of the insurance premiums, or of the taxes, or of the assessments hereinabove mentioned, or failure to pay any other indebtedness which constitutes a lien upon the real property when the same shall severally become payable, then the entire unpaid amount of the debt (less any rebate of unearned Finance Charge) secured or intended to be secured hereby shall become due, at the option of the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs or assigns, calthough the period for the payment thereof may not then have expired.

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
