Mortgagor shall promptly pay when due the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, and late charges as 2. INSURANCE. Mortgagor shall pay all taxes, assessments and charges as may be lawfully levied against the Property within thirty (30) days after the same shall be come due. In the event that Mortgagor fails to pay all taxes, assessments and charges as herein required, then Mortgagee, at its option, may pay the same and the amounts paid shall be added to the Note secured by this Mortgage. and shall be due and payable by Mortgagor to Mortgagee upon demand of Mortgagee.

4. PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTY. Mortgagor shall keep the Property in good repair and shall not commit waste or permit impairment or deterioration of the Property. Upon the failure of the Mortgagor to so maintain the Property, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter the property and cause reasonable maintenance work to be performed. Mortgagee may require immediate payment in full of the Note, foreclose the Mortgage, and seek any other remedy allowed by the law. All rents collected by the receiver shall be applied first to payment of the costs of the management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to receiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorney's fees, and then to the sums secured by this Mortgage. The receiver shall be liable to account only for those rents actually received.
