PARTIAL RELEASE OF LIEN

(Bank Loan No. 43-3-3443520-1)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other considerations, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and of the note(s) thereby secured does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release from the lien of that certain security instrument from

William Max Looper A/K/A William M. Looper and Carole C. Looper A/K/A Carol C. Looper to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, dated the 6th day of November, 1981, and

recorded in the public records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 1557, at page 226, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and being described by a plat prepared for William M. Looper, prepared by W.R. Williams, Jr. P.E. and R.L.S. No. 3979, dated September 23, 1983, revised February 22, 1983 (0.8 ac.), having the following courses and distances to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap on Mush Creek Road and running thence N31-20E, 120.0 feet to a nail and cap; thence N35-20 E, 25 feet to an iron pin; thence N35-20E, 312.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S26-16E, 120 feet to an iron pin; thence S34-27W, 297.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S34-27W, 30 feet to the point of BEGINNING and containing 0.8 acres more or less.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the security of The Federal Land Bank of Columbia as described in the aforesaid security instrument shall, in all respects, except as to the premises hereinbefore described, be preserved and protected and that the lien of said security instrument, except as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants thereof and of the note(s) thereby secured, shall remain unchanged.
