C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to be paid to the said Helton by the said Helton and truly paid by the said Helton, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns,

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville located in the City of Greenville on the southern side of Daniel Ave., formerly Mayfield Street and being the rear part of lots 1 and 2 on plan made for Miss M. M. Mayfield and Hubert Smith by H. J. Prockman, Surveyor, dated Aug. 24, 1941 and has the following mates and dimensions, to wit:
