WIENZAS, the one-fourth interest of Lillian Smith to the .966 acre tract of land has been allocated at Thirty-two thousand, five hundred (\$32,500.00) Dollars.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of Thirty-two thousand, five hundred (\$32,500.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Lillian Smith, by her attorney in fact, does hereby assign, convey and set over unto Roger S. Alexander, an undivided 1/8 interest, unto William J. Alexander, III an undivided 1/16 interest, and unto Claudine M. Alexander an undivided 1/16 interest in and to that certain note of Long Management Services, Inc. dated August 4, 1983, in the principal amount of One hundred thirty thousand (\$130,000.00) Dollars to that purchase money mortgage securing said note, it being Lillian Smith's intention to convey unto the assignees all of her undivided one-fourth right, title and interest therein.
